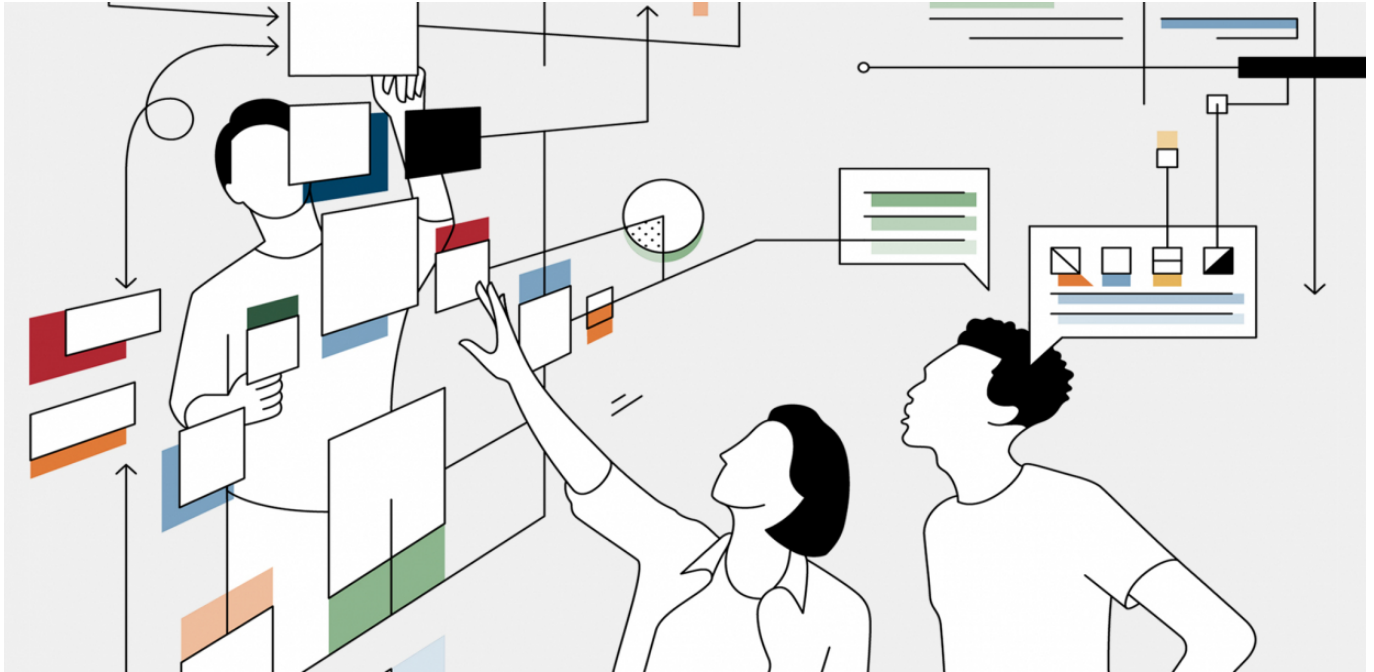


Newteaching and learning methods in higher education– Impacts on spatial needs
